ORDER :

In the Government order first read above, the Government have constituted a committee to review the working of the A.P.G.L.I. Scheme and. make suitable recommendations thereto.

2. The Director of Insurance has stated that though the A.P.G.L.I. Scheme is being implemented to the employees of A.P. Government as a compulsory scheme for more than four decades, the employees are not aware of the working of the A.P.G.L.I. Scheme and its benefits and as a result the employees are submitting the requisite forms for issue of policies, sanction of loans and settlement of claims in a very defective manner which leads to abnormal delay in disposal' of the cases.

3. The representatives of the Association through their representation second read above have suggested to publicize the procedures and salient features of the Scheme through leaflets and in newspapers.

4. The Committee has recommended that the Director of Insurance may be permitted to publish the brochures containing the salient features of the scheme; manner by which the policies are issued, the claims are settled and the loans are sanctioned including the bonus rates declared by the Government from time to time and also to print the Insurance Fund Rules, Actuarial report. Office Manual etc.

5. The A.P.N.G.Os Association in their representation third read above has requested the Government to issue suitable orders on the recommendations of the committee.

6. After careful examination of the Committee's recommendation, the Director of Insurance is permitted to publish the brochures containing the salient features and benefits of the Scheme, manner by which the policies are issued, the claims are settled and the loans are sanctioned including the bonus rates declared by the Government from time to time and also to print the A.P.G.L.I. Rules, Actuarial report and office Manual etc., given and to wide publicity through audio and video for awareness of the employees.

7. Therefore, the Director of Insurance is requested to come-up with specific proposals on each item with probable expenditure.
