In the references 1st and 2nd cited, ten Employees Associations have requested to issue policies to the employees taking the first month of recovery as the eligibility age of 21-48 years and not the submission of proposals by them.

2. In the reference 3rd cited, the Director of Insurance in his remarks has requested the government to issue orders permitting the subscribers who are in service and who were contributing premium prior to attaining 48 years of age to submit their proposal forms and obtain policies so that they can contribute premium till retirement. All such employees may be allowed a time of six months period i.e. upto 30.07.2006 for submission of proposal forms in the respective District Insurance Offices for obtaining policies, Provided they were paying premiums prior to attaining 48 years of age and are still in service (not crossed 58 years of age i.e. retirement age).

3. The Director of Insurance has further requested that during this period of six months, he may be permitted to give wide and extensive publicity to create awareness among all the employees through issue of paper notifications in all the Districts and also make correspondence with the District level and State level Employees Associations.

4. Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Director of Insurance and he is hereby permitted to

i. Accept and permit the employees to submit forms obtain Policies who are in service and who contributed the premium prior to their attaining the age of 48 years

ii. The above employees may be given six (6) months time upto 30.07.2006 to submit forms and obtain Policies.

iii. In respect of those employees who paid excess premium after crossing 48 years of age, the Director of Insurance shall take necessary action to refund such excess premium without interest.

iv. He should give wide publicity to these instructions.

5. Here after, the Director of Insurance should be very careful and ensure that the proposal forms are received from the Government employees in time and the policies are

issued promptly. The Employee's Associations should be informed about this also. The above instructions should be followed scrupulously.
