ORDER :

**A P U S**  
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In the G.O. 6th read above. Government have constituted a Committee to review the functioning of the A.P.G.L.I. Scheme and to make suitable recommendations for simplification of procedures so as to run the Scheme effectively.

In the G.O's. first and second read above, orders were issued fixing the compulsory premium towards A.P.G.L.I. Scheme as 4% of the pay in respect of Government Servants who are in Superior Grade Service. According to the Orders issued in G.O. 3rd read above, the Class-IV employees are required to insure their lives compulsorily with the A.P.G.L.I. Fund by paying premium at the rate of Rs. 4.00 per month irrespective of their basic pay.

The Committee has recommended for Introduction of slab rate of premium in lieu of existing 4% of the pay as compulsory premium so as to avoid frequent issue of policies whenever the pay of the employee crosses Rs. 100. The Committee therefore suggested the following rates of slab, with reference to Revised Scales of Pay 1993 :

Pay Slabs	Monthly Premium
Pay upto Rs. 1625	Rs. 50
Pay from Rs. 1626 to Rs. 2075	Rs. 75
Pay from Rs. 2076 to Rs. 2750	Rs. 100
Pay from Rs. 2751 to Rs. 3750	Rs. 125
Pay from Rs. 3751 to Rs. 5200	Rs. 150
Pay from Rs. 5201 and above	Rs. 200

In the reference 8th read above, the A.P. Non-Gazetted Officers association has requested the Government to issue suitable Orders on the recommendations of the Committee.

Government after careful consideration of the recommendations of the Committee issue the following orders for introduction of slab rate of premium towards A.P.G.L.I. Scheme for implementation with immediate effect :

"A Government servant irrespective of his cadre and in the age group of 21 to 48 and who has completed continuous service of one year shall insure his life with A.P.G.L.I. Fund Compulsorily by paying the monthly premium as per the rates specified below :

Pay Slabs	Monthly Premium
Pay upto Rs. 1625	Rs. 50
Pay from Rs. 1626 to Rs. 2075	Rs. 75
Pay from Rs. 2076 to Rs. 2750	Rs. 100
Pay from Rs. 2751 to Rs. 3750	Rs. 125
Pay from Rs. 3751 to Rs. 5200	Rs. 150
Pay from Rs. 5201 and above	Rs. 200

For enrollment under the Scheme, the Govt. Servant shall submit requisite proposal form after recovery- of first premium from the salary in terms of Orders issued in the G.O. 5th read above and take an insurance policy from the Insurance Department.

The Government Servants who are under insured as per the slab rates mentioned above, must increase their premiums according to the rates specified above and submit the requisite proposal forms after recovery of first, premium from their salary in terms of Orders issued in the G.O. 5th read above and take an insurance policy from the Insurance Department for the increased amount:

The Director of Treasuries and Accounts is requested to issue suitable instructions to all the Dist. Treasury Officers/Treasury Officers that the above modified orders are immediately implemented and ensure cent percent coverage of eligible employees under the A.P.G.L.I. Scheme by 31st December, 1994. The Dist. Treasuries and Sub-Treasuries/Pay and Accounts Officers should verify the collection of premium as per the slab rates before passing the salary bills.

All the Departments of Secretariat/Heads, of Departments are requested to issue suitable instructions to all their sub-ordinates to ensure that all eligible employees are brought under the A.P.G.L.I. Scheme before 31-12-1994.

Necessary amendments to A.P.G.L.I. Fund Rules will be issued separately.
