ORDER:

In the reference read above, the Director of School Education (DSE), Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad has stated that one Sri K.Bheeshmachary, a candidate of DSC-2002 who appeared for the post of Hindi Pandit Grade.II from Karimnagar District made a complaint that 21 Hindi Pandit posts were notified under BC (B) quota out of which only 16 posts were filled up and the remaining 5 posts were not filled up so far. He also reported that he was selected in District Selection Committee (DSC)-2002, but he was denied to issue appointment orders and Requested to do justice in the matter.

2. He has stated that the records relating to DSC-2002 of Karimnagar District have been initially examined by the Joint Director (Services) and found that there was a clear deviation in the selection of the candidates. As such the Additional Director (Coordination) of the office of Director of School Education, Hyderabad has been requested to enquire into the entire DSC-2002 selections of Karimnagar district and furnish his report. Accordingly the Additional Director has visited the office of the District Educational Officer (DEO), Karimnagar from 19-8-2004 to 23-8-2004 and conducted the enquiry and furnished his enquiry report vide Lr.No.Spl.1/Eng./2004-5,Dated:31.01.2005.

3. The Director of School Education, Hyderabad has also stated that, as per the report of the Enquiry Officer, it is noticed that certain candidates were irregularly selected and appointed while certain other candidates who deserve selection were denied selection in the Hindi Pandit Grade.II category, Secondary Grade Teacher category and School Assistant (Maths) category. The candidates who were irregularly selected and continuing in service have to be terminated from the service duly giving notice to them and following the procedure in vogue. The genuine candidates who deserve selections need to be selected in their places in the said category of the posts.

4 .The Government after careful consideration in the matter hereby permit the Director of School Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad to appoint the candidates who

secured higher marks than the candidates appointed in DSC-2002, Karimnagar District by terminating the candidates who were appointed with lower merit after giving them an opportunity of hearing. The terminated candidates shall be permitted to appear in the next DSC selection by giving them age relaxation, if necessary, as the candidates were selected due to mistake of authorities.

5. The Director of School Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad is requested to take action accordingly.
