**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 78 and 99 of the Andhra Pradesh Education Act. 1982 (Andhra Pradesh Act 1 of 1982) and Sub-Section (4) of section 168 and sub-section (4) of section 195 and section 268 of the Andhra Pradesh Panchayat Raj Act, 1994 (Andhra Pradesh Municipalities Act 1965 Andhra Pradesh Act No.6 of 1965) and paragraphs 5 of the fifth schedule and the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following amendments to the Andhra Pradesh Direct Recruitment of the post of Teachers (Scheme of Selection) Rules 2000 issued in G.O.Ms.No. 72, Education Department dated the 3rd July, 2000 as subsequently amended.

2. These amendments shall come into force with immediate effect.

**AMENDMENT**

In the said rules:

- 1) In Sub-clause (i) of clause (a) of Rule 2, the expression "as per rule (3) of the special rules for the Andhra Pradesh School Education Subordinate Service issued in G.O.Ms.No. 538 Education, dated the 20th November 1998 shall be omitted.
- 2) for sub rule (1) of rule 3, the following shall be substituted, namely:

**(1) Qualifications:**

(a) **AGE:** the candidates must have completed the age of 18 years and must not have completed the age of 36 years as on 1st July of the year in which notification for recruitment is made.

Provided that in the case of Backward Classes the maximum age limit is 40 years and in case of Scheduled caste and Scheduled Tribes the maximum age limit is 41 years and in the case of Physically handicapped candidates the maximum age limit is 45 years.

**Ex. Servicemen:** A person who worked in the Armed Forces of the Indian Union, shall be allowed to deduct from his age a period of 3 years in addition to the length of service rendered by him in the Armed Forces for the purposes of the maximum age limit. Provided that the person referred above shall, after making the deduction shall not exceed maximum age limit prescribed for the post.

**(b) Educational Qualifications:**

(i) **School Assistant (Mathematics):** Must possess a Bachelor Degree with Mathematics as a main subject Or one of three equal optional subjects and a B.Ed., degree with Mathematics as a methodology subject,

ii) **School Assistant (Physical Science):** Must Possess a Bachelor Degree with Physical Science and Chemistry as two of the three equal optional subjects OR one of the two as a main and the other as a subsidiary subject and B.Ed, degree with Physical Science as a methodology subject.

(iii) **School Assistant (Biological Sciences):** Must Possess a Bachelor Degree with Botany and zoology as two of the three equal optional subjects OR one of the two as a main and the other as a subsidiary subject and a B.Ed., Degree with Biological Science as a methodology subject.

iv) **School Assistant (Social Studies) :** Must Possess a Bachelor Degree with two of the following subjects as optional subjects out of three equal optional subjects OR one of them as main and another as a subsidiary subject-

a) History      b) Economics      c) Geography      d) Political Science/Public Administration and a B.Ed., Degree with Social Studies. as a methodology subject.

v) **School Assistant (English):** Must Possess a Bachelor Degree with English as a main Subject OR one of the three equal optional subjects OR a post Graduate Degree in English and a B.Ed degree with English as a methodology subject,

vi) **Language Pandit Grade-I:** Must Possess a Oriental Title in the concerned Language and Pandit Training OR B.A. with Concerned Language as one of the three equal optional subjects and Pandit training or a B.Ed., with the concerned Language as one of the methodology subjects,

vii) **Secondary Grade Teachers:** Must Possess Intermediate Certificate issued by the Board of Intermediate Education, Andhra Pradesh and D.Ed., Certificate issued by the Commissioner for Government Examination Andhra Pradesh. OR Must possess a Bachelor Degree and a B.Ed., degree .

viii) **Language Pandits Grade-II:** Must possess a Oriental Title in the concerned language and Pandit Training OR B.A. with Concerned Language as one of the three equal optional subjects and Pandit Training or a B.Ed., with concerned Language as one of the methodology' subjects,.

ix) **Physical Education Teachers:** Must Possess Intermediate Certificate issued by the Board of Intermediate Education, Andhra Pradesh and an Under Graduate Diploma in Physical Education. OR Must possess a Bachelor Degree and a B.P.Ed., degree.

**Note:** (1) The Candidates who have passed SSC Examination in the concerned medium OR with the concerned Language as First Language are eligible to apply to the posts in the concerned medium and the candidates who have passed the examination of Higher

standards in the concerned language/medium are also eligible to apply to the posts in that medium.

**c) Additional qualification (s) for the posts in schools for Blind/Deaf and Dumb:**

The Candidates applying for the posts in the schools for Blind/Deaf and Dumb must possess a certificate/Diploma/Degree in Teaching for Blind/Deaf and Dumb in addition to the academic qualifications prescribed for the posts.
