ORDER:

In pursuance of the orders issued in the references 1st and 2nd read above, Recruitment of teachers was conducted by the District Selection Committees and selected candidates were appointed in regular vacant posts as apprentice teachers on stipendiary basis for a period of 2 years and they shall be appointed to regular posts with regular scale of pay on satisfactory completion of the 2 years period of their apprenticeship. The commissioner and Director of School Education in his letter 3rd read above have submitted proposals to Government regarding applicability of Leave Rules to the teachers appointed on stipendiary basis and requested to issue necessary orders in the matter.

2. Government after careful consideration of the issue, hereby order that the apprentice teachers appointed on stipendiary basis be permitted to sanction of regular leave viz., Casual Leaves/Earned Leaves/Half-Pay Leaves, Maternity Leaves etc., besides the leave provisions contained in F.R.104, on par with regular teachers. Since the apprenticeship period will count for probation as per rule 19 of Government orders 1st read above.
