ORDER:

In the G.O. 1st read above, orders were issued introducing a scheme of Automatic Advancement for the benefit of those State Government Employees who are drawing pay in the Revised Pay Scales, 1978 falling under Grade. I to XVIII who have put in 10 or 15 years of service in a particular scale without getting promotion to a higher post. In the G.O. 2nd read above, orders were issued revising the Automatic Advancement Scheme, as recommended by the P.R.C. 1986 with effect from 01.07.1986, allowing second level promotion scale after completion of 22 years of service.

2. In the G.O. 3rd read above, order issued based on the recommendations of the P.R.C. 1993 implementing the Revised pay Scales, 1993 to the State Government Employees with effect from 01.01.1993 with monetary benefit from 01.04.1993. In the G.O. 4th read above the Revised Pay Scales, 1993 were allowed with effect from 01.07.1992 but with monetary benefit from 01.04.1993. In the G.O. 5th read above, orders were issued introducing the Revised Automatic Advancement Scheme with effect from 01.08.1993 as per the recommendations of P.R.C. 1993. In the G.O. 6th read above, orders were issued governing the Revised Automatic Advancement Scheme to Junior Lecturers.

3. In the G.O. 7th read above, orders were issued to the effect that the Revised Automatic Advancement Scheme in R.P.S. 1993 originally issued in G.O.(P) No. 290, Finance, dt.22.07.1993 shall come into force with effect from 01.07.1992 instead of from 01.08.1993 with monitory benefit from 01.04.1993. In Para 9 of the said G.O. it was specified that the appointments of certain employees already made between 01.07.1992 to 31.07.1993 to the S.P.P.I/S.A.P.P.I on completion of 15 years of service and S.P.P.II/S.A.P.P.II on completion of 22 years of service, in pursuance of the orders then in force, should not be cancelled since the modified Automatic Advancement Scheme came into force with effect from 01.08.1993.

4. In the reference 8th read above, the president, Junior Lecturers Association, Hyderabad has represented that nothing was mentioned in the case of employees in respect of whom orders of appointment to Automatic Advancement Scales were not issued, to SPP.I/SAPP.I or SPP.II/SAPP.II due to administrative reasons, though they have completed 15/22 years and were eligible for such appointments in between 01.07.1992 to 31.07.1993, and requested the Government to issue necessary orders in this regard.

5. Government, after careful consideration, hereby order that the benefit of Automatic advancement Scheme of allowing SPP.I Scale on completion of 15 years of Service and SPP.II scales of pay on completion of 22 years of service as per the scheme in force prior to issue of orders in G.O. 7th read above shall also be allowed to those who have completed the stipulated number of years of service and respect of whom orders of appointment were not issued due to administrative reasons, if they were otherwise eligible for such appointments between the period from 01-07-1992 to 31-07-1993.

6. The monitory benefit shall, however, accrue with effect from 01-04-1993.
