ORDER:

APUS

Based on the modified orders of the Government of India on the above subject conveyed through their letter 2nd cited the following amendments are issued to the G. O.1st cited.

AMENDMENTS

For Para 3(1) of G. O. Ms. No. 262, Fin. & Plg. (FW. TA) Dept. dt. 25-8-80 the following shall be substituted:-

"Conveyance Allowance shall be allowed to an Orthopaedically handicapped employee if he or she has a minimum of 40% permanent particle disability of either upper or lower limbs, or 50% permanent partial disability or both upper and lower limbs together".

Add the following as paras 7 & 8 after Para 6 of the G. O. Ms. No. 262, Fin. & Plg. (FW-TA) Dept., dt 25-8-1980.

7. For estimation of disability, the standards as contained in the Manual for Orthopedic Surgeon in Evaluation permanent physical impairment brought out by the American Academic of Orthopedic Surgeons, U.S.A- and published on their behalf by Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation of India, G. T. Road, Kanpur, shall apply.

8. In cases, where handicapped Government servants are referred by Heads of Departments concerned to Government Civil Hospitals located at stations outside their Headquarters for getting recommendations for grant of conveyance, they shall be reimbursed the actual traveling expenses, according to their grades under A. P. T. A. Rules, subject to maximum of T. A. admissible for a journey on tour without any daily allowance for the period of journeys and halts. The period spent on journey and also at the hospital, shall however be treated as duty. No fee shall be charged by Government Hospitals from the handicapped employees when they are referred to such hospitals by the Heads of Departments for making recommendations regarding grant of conveyance allowance.
