ORDER :-

At present the teaching and non – teaching staff of Educational Institutions under all management including Government are governed by the revised leave rules 1933. How ever, Casual Leaves and Optional Holidays do not form or part of leaves.

Casual leave is not provided under the fundamental rules, but is regulated under the executive instructions in Annexure VII to the fundamental rules. These rules are applicable to the employee of both vocation and non – vacation Departments, However , provision has been given for special casual leave of 7 days in a calendar year to the employees of vacation Department. A doubt has been raised in the letter 2nd read above, whether the orders issued in the Government order 1st read above enhancing the casual leave to 15 days and optional holidays to 5 days from the calendar year 1981 are applicable to the teaching and non teaching staff of Educational Institutions under different managements.

Government have examined the matter and hereby clarify that the orders issued in the Government order Ist read above shall apply to the teaching and non – teaching staff of all Educational Institutions irrespective of the management under whose control they are functioning. It is also further clarified that whenever any order regarding the eligibility of casual leave of optional holidays is issued in respect of Government employees, it shall automatically apply to the teaching and non teaching staff of all Educational institutions under all managements without the need for issuing a separate order in respect of such staff in future.
