The attention of the commissioner and Director of School Education, is invited to the referencen cited and he is informed that the cases relating to the appointment of dependent of deceased teachers/retired teachers of Z.P. Management on medical invalidation, if it is to the post of teacher (ie., if the dependcxt have all required qualifications to appoint him as teachers) then the concerned District Educational officdr is competent to dispose of such cases as per standing instructions of the Government issued from time to time since the District Educational officer is the appointing authority to the post of Teachers in terms of g.o.Ms.No. 538 dt. 20.11.1998. If the request of the dependent of deceased teacher retired teacher on medical invalidation for appointment to the post of Class IV and Ministerial post such cases to be dealt by the Cheif Executive Office concerned and the District Educational Officer concerned shall furnish all necessary particular information to the concerned Chief Executive Officer for taking further action

2. Further he is informed that the contention raised by the district educational Officer, Mahabubnagar that cases relating to appointment of dependents of deceased teachers of Z.P. Management/retired on medical invalidation pending prior to the issue of G.O. 538 Edn., dt. 20.11.1998 has to be dealt by the Cheif Executive officer, mahabubnagar is not correct. All the pending cases which are stiull pending undisposed as on 20.11.98 shall be entertained and disposed off by the District Educational officer/Chief Executive officer concerned as indicated at Pra-1 above irrespective of the date of pendency.

3. The Commissioner & Director of School Education, is therefore requested to issue the above clarificatory instructions to all District Educational officers/Cheif Executive Officer, Further he is also requested to examine the cases as sper the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No. 202, and 203, G.A. (Ser.A) Dept. dt. 27.4.2002, in respect to government employees who retire on Medical invalidation.
