**ORDER:**

Government have issued orders granting conveyance allowance at 10% of basic pay subject to a maximum of Rs.50/- to the blind and orthopaedically handicapped Govt. Employees for going to and coming from the place of their duty in G.O .Ms.No.262, Finance and Planning, dt,25-8-1980 subject to certain conditions stipulated therein.

(2) The General Secretary A.P.P.Raj Ministerial Employees Association has requested that the P.Raj Employees who are blind and orthopeadlccally handicapped may also be allowed conveyance allowance on par with Govt. Employees.

(3) Government after careful consideration of the request of the Association have decided to extend the concession of payment of Conveyance Allowance allowed to the Blind & Orthopaedically Handicapped State Government Employees in the G.O. read above to such employees of P.Raj Department also. Government accordingly hereby order that the Blind & Orthopaedically Handicapped P.Raj (Non-Govt.) employees be allowed a conveyance allowance at 10% of bade pay subject to the following conditions, The expenditure will be met from the head of account to which their salaries are debited.

(a) An Orthopaedically handicapped employee will be eligible for conveyance allowance only, if he has a maximum of 40% permanent partial disability of both the upper and lower extremity deformities.

(b) The conveyance allowance shall be admissible to the orthopaedically handicapped employees on the recommendations of the orthopaedical Surgeon of Government Hospital not below the rank of Civil Surgeon.

(c) In the case of blind employees, the allowance shall be admissible on the recommendation of an ophthalmologist of a Government Hospital not below the rank of Civil Surgeon.

(d) The allowance will not be admissible during leave (except casual leave) joining time or suspension.

(4) The P.Raj employees concerned shall accordingly apply for the grant of conveyance allowance to the head of his office in which he is working. It shall be the responsibility of the head of office concerned to refer the applications to the appropriate medical authority indicated above for obtaining a certificate for the grant of the conveyance allowance admissible under these orders if the head of the office is a non-gazetted officer, the conveyance allowance under these orders shall be sanctioned by the next immediate gazetted officer of the department.

(5) The concession shall be given from the date of recommendations of the medical authority is received by the head of office. In the case of existing employees the concession may be extended from the date of the order.

(6) The Bus pass concession extended to the Government employees will not be admissible to employees who are eligible for the concession under these orders.

(7) This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance and Planning (F.W.) Department, vide their G.O.No.55066-A/1232/Ex.PR & FRD/80-81, dated 12-12-1980.
