InG.O.Ms.No. 165. Genl.Admn (Ser.C) Department, dated. 22.4.1997 an adhoc rule was issued to exempt such of those employees who have crossed 45 years of age from passing of Departmental Tests/Special Tests prescribed in the Special Rules/ Adhoc Rules for the purpose of the promotion to the next higher category i.e.., promotion/appointment by transfer to a post above the one held by him/her., if they could not pass the same.

- 2. The circular Memo. No. 49152/Ser.C/97, dated GA (Ser.C) Department dated 28.7.97 a clarification was issued about the applicability of adhoc rule.
- 3. Various departments have sought for further clarfication on certain points in respect of adhoc rule issued in G.O.Ms.No. 165, Genl. Admn (Ser.C) Dept., dated 22.4.1997 and they are clarified as follows:

The exemption is not available for a second promotion to such employees who had already got one promotion even if it is for a post which no tests are prescribed. This is because of the intention of the Govt. to ensure that every employee gets at least one promotion.
