**ORDER :-**

1. Employees in the Educational in Institutions who avail the summer vacation are eligible for Earned Leave of three days per annum subject to the provisions under F.R. 82. The Joint Action Committee of Employees, Teachers and Workers and Teacher's Organizations have entered into an agreement on 22 – 10 – 1989 with the Government. One of the items of the agreement is that the Teaching and Non-teaching staff in Educational Institutions, who now enjoy the facility of 3 days Earned Leave per annum will hereafter be made eligible for 5 days Earned Leave for year.

2. Government after careful consideration direct that all Teaching and Non – Teaching staff in the Education Institutions who are availing summer vacations and are eligible for 3 days earned leave for annum shall be eligible for 5 days Earned Leave against the present 3 days Earned Leave for annum subject to the provision of F.R. 82. According their Earned leave for each year of duty in which they have availed themselves of the vacation shall be reduced by 28 days, as they are ordinarily entitled to leave at the rate of one – eleventh of the period spent on duty. If a part only of the vacation has been taken in any year the period so reduced shall be a fraction of 28 days as the case may be equal to the proportion which the part of the vacation taken bears to the full period of vacation.

3. These orders shall come into force with effect from 1-11-1989.

4. Necessary amendments to the F.R.S. will be issued by the Finance and Planning (F.W.F.R.I.) Department, in due course.

5. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance and Planning (F.W.F.R.I.) Department vide their V.O.No. D-8910/74/890/FRI/89. dated 18-11-1989.
