ORDER

**APUS**  
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In the G.O. read above, rules governing the Andhra Pradesh Employees Welfare Fund have been issued. These rules, inter-alia, provide for the constitution of the State Committee, District Committees and Twin Cities Committee for the purpose of operating the fund. Among the Members of the various Committees, the members representing Gazetted Officers and Local Bodies Employees, are to be elected by the respective Associations and sent to the Committees. As the representatives are not being sent by the respective Service Association following the election process laid down in the rules, difficulties are experienced in reconstituting the committees after the expiry of the term on 31-3-1983. Government have examined the provisions relating to constitution of the State Level Committee, District Committee and Twin Cities Committee with a view to see that the respective committees are constituted early and function in accordance with the rules. Government have decided to amend the rules so that there should not be a vacuum as at present.

2. The following amendments are accordingly issued to the Andhra Pradesh Employees Welfare Fund Rules, 1980, annexed to the G.O. read above.,

**THE AMENDMENTS**

(1) in Rule 9, :

(a) for Notes 1, 2 and 3 under sub-rule (1) the following notes shall be substituted, namely:-

Note: 1 For this purpose, the Chief Secretary shall nominate a representative who holds the office of President/Chairman of a recognized Gazetted Officers Association. The nomination should be so made that all the recognized Gazetted Officers Associations have an opportunity to be represented on the Committee by turn.

Note: 2 For this purpose, the Chief Secretary shall nominate a representative who holds the office of President/Chairman of the recognized Association of Panchayat Raj Institutions or Municipalities. The nominations should be so made that all the recognized Associations of Panchayati Raj Institutions and Municipalities have an opportunity to be represented on the Committee by turn.

Note 3:- For this purpose, the Chief Secretary shall nominate a representative of Work Charged Establishment. The representative so nominated shall not be eligible for re-nomination for subsequent term".

(b) after sub-rule (1) the following sub-rule shall be added namely:-

(2) "The members mentioned at serial Nos. (ii), (iii) and (iv) of item (e) under sub-rule (1) shall hold office for a period of two years from the date of nomination, or till the end of March immediately following the period of two years from the date of nomination. If however, a vacancy arises during the middle of a term that vacancy shall be filled up in the manner laid down for nomination of the respective member and such member shall hold office for the remaining period of that term".

(2) rule 10 shall be omitted:

(3) in rule 17,

(a) in sub-rule (2) -

(i) in Note 1, for the words one year the words 'two years' shall be substituted.

(ii) for Notes 2, 3 and 4, the following notes shall be substituted; namely;

Note 2:- "The representatives of the departments referred to in rules 17 (1) (c) and 17 (2) (c) shall be nominated by-the Collectors in the case of District Committees and the Commissioner of Land Revenue in the case of the Twin Cities Committee".

Note 3:- "(a) In the case of District Committees, the Collector shall nominate a representative who holds the office of President/Chairman of a recognized Gazetted Officers Association of the respective districts. The nomination should be so made that all the recognized Gazetted Officers Associations of the respective districts have an opportunity to be represented on the Committee by turn.

(b) In the case of District Committees, the Collectors shall nominate a representative of Local Bodies Employees or Municipalities other than teachers, who holds the office of President/Chairman of a recognized Association of Panchayat Raj Institutions or Municipalities Association of the respective districts. The nomination should be so made that all the recognized Associations of the respective Districts have an opportunity to be represented on the Committee by turn.

(c) In the case of District Committees the Collectors shall nominate a representative of Work Charged Establishment of that District. The representative so nominated shall not be eligible for renomination for subsequent term.

Note 4:- (a) In the case of Twin Cities Committee, the Commissioner of Land Revenue shall nominate two representatives to represent the Andhra Pradesh Non-Gazetted Officers' Association, the State Teachers Union and one each to represent Andhra Pradesh Secretariat Association and Class-IV Employees Central Association. The representatives so nominated shall not be eligible for renomination for subsequent term.

(b) In the case of Twin Cities Committee the Commissioner of Land Revenue shall nominate a representative who holds the office of the President/Chairman of a recognized Gazetted Officers Association. The nomination should be so made that all the recognized Gazetted Officers Association have an opportunity to be represented on the Committee by turn.

(c) In the case of the Twin Cities Committee the Commissioner of Land Revenue shall nominate a representative of Local Bodies Employees OF Municipalities other than Teachers who holds the office of the President/Chairman of a recognized Association of Panchayati Raj Institutions or Municipalities. The nomination should be so made that all the recognized Associations have an opportunity to be represented on the Committee by term.

(d) In the case of the Twin Cities Committee, the Commissioner of Land Revenue shall nominate a representative of any Work Charged Establishment in the Twin Cities. The representative so nominated shall not be eligible for renomination for subsequent term". (b) for sub-rule (3) the following sub-rule shall be substituted namely:-

(3) "The members mentioned at items (c), (e) (ii) (iii) and (iv) of sub-rule (1), and at item (c) and (d) (i) to (viii) of sub-rule (2), shall hold office for a period of two years From the date of nomination, or till. the end of March immediately following the period of two years from the date of nomination. If however, a vacancy arises in the middle of a term that vacancy shall be filled up in the manner laid down for nomination of the respective members and such member shall hold office for the remaining period of that term".
