ORDER:

According to Rule 14 (2) of the A-P-Employees Welfare Fund Rules, 1980 issued in G.O. 1st read above, in cases of emergency the Chairman of the State Committee may sanction Assistance to a member or his family/dependents of a deceased employee not exceeding Rs. 1000/- in any one case subject to ratification of the action in the next meeting of the State Committee, provided that the total assistance so sanctioned by the Chairman does not exceed Rs. 5,000/- in between two consecutive meetings of the State Committee. According to Rule 17 (8) (b) of the above said Rules, in cases of emergency the President of District Committee and (he Twin Cities Committee may sanction assistance to a member or his family/ dependents of a deceased employee and the Twin Cities Committee may sanction assistance to a member or his family/Dependents of a deceased employee not exceeding Rs. 500/- in any one case and not exceeding Rs. 2.500/- in a year in all cases put together subject to ratification of the action at the immediately next meeting of Committee Twin Cities Committee.

2. In the meeting of the State Level Committee of the A.P. Employees Welfare Fund held at 11.00 A.M. on 2-7-1991, it was agreed to enhance the existing limit of Rs. 500/- to Rs. 1,000/- for sanctioning assistance in emergency cases by the President of the District Committee and also raise the maximum limit of Rs. 2,500/- to Rs. 5000/- for a year. It was also decided that the powers of the Chairman, State Level Committee may also be revised to Rs. 2.000/- from the existing limit of Rs. 1.000/- for each case and the present limit of Rs. 5000/- may be raised to Rs. 10,000/- for a year.

3. Accordingly, the following amendment is issued to the A.P. Employees Welfare Fund Rules, 1980.

AMENDMENT

The following shall substitute Rule 14 (2) of the A.P. Employees Welfare Fund Rules, 1980.

In cases of emergency, the Chairman may sanction assistance to a member or his family/dependents of a deceased employee not exceeding Rs.2,000/- in any one case subject to ratification of the action at the immediately next meeting of the State Committee;

Provided that the Total assistance so sanctioned by the Chairman does not exceed Rs. 10,000- a year.

Similarly the Rule 17 (8) (b) shall be substituted by the following:

In cases of emergency, the President may sanction assistance to a member OF his family/dependents of a deceased employee not exceeding Rs. 1000/- in any case and not exceeding Rs. 5000/- in a year in all cases put together subject to ratification of the action at the immediately next meeting of the Committee/ Twin Cities Committee.
