The following clarifications are issued regarding A.P. State Employees Group Insurance Scheme 1984 for the guidance of Heads of Offices:-

POINT.1: Whether the anniversary of the New Group Insurance Scheme is April or November as the illustration given in G.O.Ms.No..293, Fin.,& Plg.(FW) Department,, dt.8-10-84 refers to April.

CLARIFICATION: As the Scheme has come into force with effect from 1-11-84, the anniversary of the scheme is November of each year. Those employees who are promoted/appointed during any month other than November of each year. will become full members of the scheme from the 1st of November following the dated appointment/promotion.

POINT.2(a): Whether the Group Insurance Scheme is applicable to purely temporary employees who are not likely to continue in service, and

CLARIFICATION: As the intention is to cover all employee; by this scheme, even purely temporary employees will have to subscribe to this scheme, provided they complete one year of service. They should however be medically examined and found fit for Govt. Service before appointment.

POINT.2(b): Whether recovery of subscription at higher slabs has to be made when temporary promotions are given.

CLARIFICATION: As recovery of subscription at higher rates, owing to change of Group on promotion, will be only from the next anniversary of the scheme, irrespective of the nature of promotion/reversion being temporary. The composite subscription shall be revised only from the anniversary of the scheme. If the composite subscription has to

be raised or lowered as a result of change should be effected from the 1st November, following the promotion/reversion when the anniversary of the scheme falls.

POINT .3(a): Whether the Special Grade/Special Promotion scales or increments beyond maximum of the scale should be taken into account for purpose of deciding the group to which an employee belongs.

CLARIFICATION: The Groups to which they belong shall be decided on the basis of the actual scale of pay they are drawing from time to time.

POINT. 3(b): Whether Dearness Pay drawn by Lecturers in U.G.C. Scales of pay shall be added for purpose of deciding the Group to which they are eligible.

CLARIFICATION: In the case of Lecturers who are holding non Dearness Allowance merged Scales of Pay, the Group to which they are eligible shall be decided by adding Dearness pay to their scales of pay and arriving at the minimum of the probable scale.

In order to facilitate easy verification, Government have decided that in respect of State Government Employees who are deputed to Government of India or other States or on foreign service, the foreign employer shall furnish a list of remittances to the scheme in the following Proforma every year along with copies of challans invariably to the administrator of the scheme marking a copy to the concerned Head of the Department.
