ORDER:

According to the orders issued in G.O. 1st read above a subscriber to General Provident Fund can not for the stoppage of subscriptions to the Fund four months prior to his retirement on superannuation.

In the G.O. 2nd read above, instructions, were issued to all the Heads of Departments etc., to furnish details of deductions made from the Pay bills towards General Provident Fund during the last 12 months proceeding the date of retirement of the subscriber so that the Accountant General could post these credits in the account of the subscriber in advance and authorize full payment of General Provident Fund balance to the subscriber at one time.

In his letter 3rd read above, the senior Deputy Accountant General has brought to the notice of the Government, the orders of Government of India in their office Memorandum 4th read above and requested Government to consider the possibility of adopting the above orders by this State Government. The Government after careful consideration hereby order that:

i) The present procedure relating to submission of application for final payment of General Provident Fund balances by the subscriber one year in advance of the date of his retirement on superannuation shall continue to be followed.

ii) A Government servant due to retirement on superannuation shall be exempted from making any subscription to the General Provident Fund during the last four months of his Service. The discontinuance of subscription shall be compulsory and not optional,.

iii) For the purpose of Rule-30-A of General Provident Fund (AP) Rules relating to social Security-cum-Provident Fund booster scheme subscriber would continue to be treated as a subscriber till his retirement even though recovery of subscriptions is

discontinued for the last 4 months of his service so that in the event of his unfortunate death during the above period the person entitled to receive the amount standing to the credit of the subscriber could be paid the additional amount as envisaged in Ruel-30-A of General Provident Fund (A.P) Rules.

iv) The procedure the Head of Departments to furnish statement of deduction prior to 12 months of retirement of the subscriber to the Accountant General A.P. Ordered in the G.O. 2nd read above may be followed scrupulously.
