**ORDER:**

In the G.O. first read above, orders were issued amending rule 13(4) of the General Provident Fund (AP) Rules stating that “In addition to any amount to be paid under rules 28,29 or 30 interest thereon up to the end of the month preceding the month in which final payment is made shall be payable to the person to whom such amount is to be paid.”

2. In the G.O. 2nd read above, orders were issued amending Rule 13(4) of the General Provident Fund (Andhra Pradesh) Rules stating that for the words “final payment is made”, the words “final payment is authorized by the Accountant General” shall be substituted.

3. The Accountant General, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad., in the letter 3rd cited, has brought to the notice of the Government that there is no mention in the amended sub-rule regarding payment of interest in cases where the delay is mainly due to late submission of applications by the subscribers and not due to any administrative delay and requested to give clarification whether the amended sub rule is applicable to all cases irrespective of nature of delay or whether to cases where there is inordinate delay on the part of the subscribers, interest is to be allowed up to maximum of six months after the month in which such amount became payable.

4. Government after careful examination of the matter, decided that there is no necessity to pay interest in the cases where the delay is mainly due to late submission of applications by the subscribers and decided to amend Rules 13(4) of the General Provident Fund (A.P) Rules accordingly.

5. Accordingly, the following notification will be published in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette:

**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred to the Proviso to Article 309 read with article 313 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following amendment to the General Provident Fund (Andhra Pradesh) Rules:

**AMENDMENT**

In the sub rule (4) of Rule 13 of the said rules, for the words “shall be payable to the person to whom such amount is to be paid”, the words “shall be payable to the subscriber in case of administrative delay only” shall be substituted.
