ORDER:

In the G.O. read above orders were issued sanctioning the D.A. to the State Government Employees. In Para 5.3 of the G.O. it was ordered that the arrears of D.A., for the period from 1.7.1993 to 31.3.1994 shall be credited to 8005 - State Provident Fund. MH. 101 GPF-SH (03) Compulsory Savings Scheme under Public Account to be transferred whenever opened.

2. The following further orders are issued for the maintenance of Account Under (03) Compulsory Savings Schemes by all departments concerned.

3. The Drawing Officers will retain one copy of schedule as contemplated in Para (7) & (8) of the G.O. read above containing the particulars of name of the employee, the period of arrears and amount of G.P.F, credited to (03) Compulsory Savings Scheme.

4. Each Drawing Officer shall prepare an intimation, in duplicate in the following proforma and furnish to each employee retaining one copy in the office.

1. Name of the Employee
2. Designation
3. Office
4. Designation of the Drawing Officer
5. Designation of Audit Officer
6. Amount of arrears of D.A. claimed and credited under (03) C.S.S. Account.
7. Bill No. and date
8. Voucher No.
9. T.No. in which claim was admitted.

10, Interest rate - 12% of simple interest calculated from 1-5-1994 till the transfer of amount to regular G.P.F.

5. Action should be initiated by the Departmental Drawing and Disbursing Officers for submitting proposals for opening regular G.P.F. Account number to Accountant - General (A & E), Hyderabad as when the Govt. officials become eligible to subscribe to GPF soon after allotment of GPF account numbers by Account-General (A & E) A.P., Hyderabad, an adjustment bill should be preferred by the Drawing and disbursing Officer for transferring the amount under compulsory saving scheme to the regular GPF.

6. In respect of Class IV GPF the D.T.O./P.A.O., should take action transfer the amount from SH (03) Compulsory savings scheme to SH (05) class - IV General Provident Fund.

7. All the Heads of Departments are requested to take prompt action in the matter.
