Sub:- Secondary Education – Head Master allowance in respect of teachers working as Head Masters / Non-Panel Headmasters in High Schools – Clarification – Issued.

A P U S

The Director of School Education in his letter first cited has raised the following points for clarification for sanctioning additional charge allowance for the following two categories.

- 1) Where there are sanctioned posts of Panel Grade Head Masters available and School Assistants are posted as I/c Head Masters and
- 2) Where Panel Grade Head Masters are not sanctioned by the competent authority and School Assistants are holding the posts of Head Masters in incomplete High Schools in addition to their own duties.

The above points have been examined and it is hereby clarified that where there are sanctioned posts of Panel Grade Head Masters available and School Assistants are posted as I/c Head Masters there is no objection for placing such School Assistants as in charge - Head Masters and sanction additional charge allowance provided if the State Fundamental Rules apply to them.
