The General Secretary, Panchayat Raj Teachers Union, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad has represented that the Teachers/School Assistant who are discharging the functions, of Headmasters in upgraded High Schools are not being paid Headmaster Allowance by the Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad, R.R. District.

The Chief Executive Officer, Z.P..Ranga Reddy District in his letter 2nd read above has reported that the Special pay is admissible to the Teachers/School Assistants who are discharging the duties of Headmasters in Upper Primary Schools as per G.O.Ms.No. 216, Finance & Planning Department, dt. 27.5.1993. But there is no indication about the Headmaster allowance to be paid to the Teachers/School Assistants who are discharging the duties of Headmasters in upgraded High Schools.

However, the matter has been examined with reference to the instructions issued in G.M. No. 896/Ser. IV-1/90-2, Education dt. 28 311 and G.O.Ms. No. 988/Ser. IV-1/91-1, Education, dated. 7.12.1991 and hereby clarified that this is not a new issue but only intended to cover the School Assistants who are kept as incharge Headmasters afresh to an upgrade High Schools where the posts of Headmasters could not be sanctioned shall be eligible for Upper Primary Schools.

The receipt of these proceedings may be acknowledged.
