ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, it was ordered that all the Headmasters of High Schools under all managements in the state should stay in their respective schools for 17 days from 24th April to 10th May and 1st June to date of re-opening to look after the post examination work and to prepare academic programme /Institutional plan in advance and the Head Masters prevented from availing summer vacation should be eligible for preservation of 10 days earned leave in lieu of prevented summer vacation for the academic year 1993-94 only.

2. The General Secretary, A.P. Head Master's Association in his representation second read above has represented that the Head Masters of High Schools in the State are restrained from 24th April to 10th May and from 1st June to the re-opening day of the Schools i.e., 13th June of the year,. He has also stated that in lieu of curtailment of the Summer vacation, the Government has sanctioned 10 days earned leave, since each year for the years 1991-92, 1992-93 and 1993-94., however the same was stopped for the seasons not known from 1994-95 onwards, and therefore requested to continue sanction of 10 days Earned Leave.

3. Government examined the representation in consultation with Director of School Education and hereby order for extension of the benefit of 10 days earned leave to Head Master s ion lieu of prevented summer vacation subject to the condition that these preserved 10 days Earned Leave shall be allowed to and countable for encashment.
