Sub:- Janmabhoomi – Education Department- Certain Instructions for the 17th round of Janmabhoomi from 1st to 10th June – Regarding.

A P U S

All the District Educational Officers are informed that Janmabhoomi is going to be organized from 1st June to 10th June. The following action is to be taken at the Gram Panchayat Level.

1. The Head Master/Senior Teacher of the primary school will organize a rally of Children in the Village in the morning and bring them to the Gram Sabha.
2. The School Education committee members will verify the names of Children And prepare a comprehensive list of children in the age group of 5-15 years, those who are already attending schools and those who are not.
3. They will discuss the cases of children who are not yet enrolled in school and evolve a strategy to bring them to school from June onwards. Names of persons 'who will take the responsibility of bringing the children to school will be listed.
4. All children attending Angan wadies who have completed 5 years should be enumerated and list kept ready for admission to class I.
5. A draft report will be prepared by the school education committee on the status of School Education and present it to the Gram Sabha.
6. A resolution will be passed by the Gram Sabha expressing a commitment to enroll all children in the village and retain them till they complete 10th grade. A format for this resolution has been developed (enclosed) to help Gram Sabhas to structure their discussions.
7. Gram Panchayat with 100% Girls Child enrolment will be identified during the Janmabhoomi . A Commendation Certification for these Gram Panchayats will be given during Chaduvula Panduga in July.
8. 100 best literacy Volunteers in each Mandal who has made maximum number of persons literate under Akshara Sankranthi will be identified. Proposals for giving the opportunities for further studies will be compiled during the Janmabhoomi.
9. The resolution by the Gram Sabha would contain a review of adult literacy situation in the village and the steps proposed to be taken by the Village

- committee to strengthen the existing programme and expand to include all illiterate adults.
10. Best Student of the Village who got highest marks in the Village in 7th and 10th class to be felicitated. A certificate of Commendation signed by the District Collector to be given to them during the Gram Sabha meetings of Janmabhoomi.
 11. All Teachers shall organize exhibition in which locally prepared. TLM Material for adult literacy Innovative materials prepared, Plan to improve the School , Chart showing role of Parents, community and the teachers. List of “Out of School” children, display of posters on Child Labour, Girl Child Education, Education for disabled children shall be exhibited.
 12. The Mandal Educational Officers should compile such resolutions and other information as mentioned in paras above for their area and submit it to District Educational Officer by 15th June, Top priority may be given by M.E.O.s and DEOs to this item and submit the resolutions on time. The [performance of the M.E.O.s and DEOs would be judged based on prompt submission of these resolution.
 13. All the Teachers shall attend Janmabhoomi. They would be leave preservation for 2 days (i.e., on the day of Gram Sabha and a day before for making arrangements) . The list of teachers who attended Janmabhoomi Programme would be prepared by Nodal Officers and MEOs to compile for giving them leave preservation.

The formats developed for resolution by the Mandal Parishad and learning guarantee by the teachers are also enclosed for necessary action.
