In the reference 2nd above, the Director of Government Examinations, A.P. Hyderabad has informed that the Govt. have decided to conduct the S.S.C. Advanced Supplementary Examinations in the months of May/June,2004 which are tentatively fixed i.e., from 26-05-2004 to 08-06-2004 for the failed candidates for the S.S.C. Public examinations held in March,2004.

In view of the above, all the District Educational Officers in the state are requested to take immediate necessary actions on the following.

- 1) To present all the Heads of Secondary School under all managements along with their non-teaching staff including class IV service personnel from availing summer vacation with effect from 1-5-2004.
- 2) To direct the teachers who are drafted for invigilation work in accordance with reference 3 to report to the D.E.O'S one week before the commencement of the examinations to receive the instructions in connections with the work of the S.S.C. Advanced supplementary examinations effect from (1-5-2004) May/June,2004.
- 3) Earned Leave may be preserved for all those employees who are prevented from availing summer vacations as per F.R.82.
- 4) The receipt of these proceedings should be acknowledged . This has got the approval of the Commissioner and Director of School Education.
