In the reference read above , the Director of Government Examinations , A.P. Hyderabad has informed that the Government have decided to Advance the conduct of the SSS Supplementary Examinations in the months of May/June, 2001 i.e., from 25-5-2001 to 9-6-2001 for the failed candidates of the SSC Public Examinations held in March, 2001, in view of the above the District Educational Officers in the state are requested to take necessary action on the following.

- i) To prevent all the Heads of Secondary Schools under all managements long with their Non-teaching staff including Class-IV services personal from availing summer vacation with effect from 1-5-2001.
- ii) To direct the teachers who are drafted for invigilation work to report them on 15-5-2001 to receive the instructions in connection with the work of the SSC Advanced Supplementary Examinations, May/June,2001.
- iii) Earned Leave may be preserved for all these employees who are prevented from availing summer vacation as per F.R.82.

They are further informed that where there are no sanctioned posts of Jr. Assts, one teacher who has been entrusted with the work of Jr. Asst. May be prevented from availing summer vacation from 1-5-2001.
