Certain teacher's Associations have represented to the Government that the Teachers , who are on summer vacation have been instructed by the concerned election authorities not to leave the head quarters on the eve of General Elections to Lok Sabha, 1991 so as to attend to the training classes and also for election duty, The Associations have, there, requested for grant of Earned Leave to the Teaching Staff drafted for election duty in lieu of loss of their summer vacation.

2. Government after careful examination have decided to delegate powers to the concerned Heads of Educational Institutions in this regard and they accordingly order that the concerned Heads of Educational Institutions shall credit the number of days the teaching staff actually spent for attending training classes and the number of days of actual election duty to their Earned Leave account based on the attendance certificate issued by the Returning Officers concerned,

3. The Returning Officers are authorized to issue the attendance certificates for the actual days on which the Teaching Staff have attended to the training classes and election duty,.

4. Government also direct that the remuneration offered for the number of days spent for undergoing training and for the number of days actually spent on election duty during the vacation shall not be treated as remuneration within the scope of ruling 15 under F.R.82.
