ORDER

The following amendment is issued to the Andhra Pradesh Integrated Medical Attendance Rules, 1972 :

AMENDMENT

For the rule 22 of the Rules, the following shall be substituted :

All categories of Government Servants and other entitled persons who are eligible under current rules for reimbursement of expenses on medical treatment within India would be eligible for reimbursement of expenses incurred on medical treatment outside India for which facilities are available in this Country also, subject to the maximum of Rs. 40,000 (Rupees forty thousand only) which includes. Air Passage of Patient and expenditure incurred towards Personal Attendant also.

They are also eligible for the reimbursement of the actual expenditure on such medical treatment where there are no facilities available in the Country. Expenditure on

air-passage of the person treated as well as the air passage of the accompanying personal attendant would also be reimbursed by Government in such cases.

Note:

The Authorized Medical Attendant should certify whether there is need for treatment abroad and prior approval of the Director of Medical Education/Government in Medical & Health should be obtained by the person who wants to secure treatment outside the Country. The expenditure to be reimbursed should be certified by the Director of Medical Education.
