The following amendment is issued to the Andhra Pradesh Integrated Medical Attendance Rules, 1972:

AMENDMENT

For the Note (2) u/r 5(9) of the Rules, the following shall be substituted:

The cost of Artificial limbs, hearing aids, corrective glasses, artificial Teeth and Invalid chairs, changes are reimbursable to the eligible patients who are entitled to the facilities for sanction of medical reimbursement'. These orders shall come into force with effect from 1-3-1990.
