ORDER

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In the G.O.s 4th read above, Government have enhanced the maximum ceiling limit from Rs. 50,000/- to Rs. 75,000/- to Government employees and their dependants towards reimbursement of expenses incurred by them subject to the conditions specified therein.

2. The Cabinet Sub-committee on services held discussions on various demands of the A.P. Secretariat Employees Coordination committee on 17.9.2001 including the above demand.

3. In the reference 5th read above, the A.P. Secretariat Employees Coordination Committee among other things have represented to waive the upper ceiling limit of Rs. 75,000/- for medical reimbursement in respect of major ailments relating to Heat, Kidney and Cancer etc. In the reference 7th read above, the decision of the Government on the above demand has been communicated as mutually agreed to by the Government and the representatives of A.P. Secretariat Employees Coordination Committee on 18.9.2001. The Government and the A.P. Secretariat Employees Coordination Committee have mutually agreed to raise the ceiling from the existing Rs. 75,000/- to Rs. 1,00,000/- in case of Bypass Surgery, Kidney Transplantation, Neuro Surgery and Cancer subject to however within the existing budgetary allocation.

4. Government after careful examination of the matter have decided that the maximum ceiling of Rs. 75,000/- be raised to Rs. 1,00,000/- for reimbursement of medical expenses for the treatment of Bypass Surgery, Kidney Transplantation, Neuro Surgery only. The enhancement of limit should be limited to serving employees only and not to the pensioners. However the existing limit of Rs. 75,000/- be continued for the pensioners.

5. Accordingly Government hereby enhance the maximum ceiling limit from existing Rs. 75,000/- to Rs. 1,00,000/- of reimbursement of medical expenses for the treatment of Bypass Surgery, Kidney Transplantation, Neuro Surgery only limited to the serving employees and their dependants. These orders will not apply to the retired employees. Any expenditure in excess of the enhanced ceiling limit shall however be borne by the Government Employees only. The procedure of requirement of referral letter by NIMS/SVIMS to obtain treatment in recognized private hospital shall however be continued.

6. This order will come into force with immediate effect.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide their U.o. No. 539/130/A2/2002, dated 27.2.2002.
