ORDER: **A P U S**

Under the welfare measures, the Govt. have evolved and introduced a scheme by which the nearest relative of the deceased Govt. employee or the person lawfully in possession of the body of the deceased Govt. employees whether gazetted or non gazetted, is at present eligible to receive financial assistance of not more than Rs. 300/- depending on circumstances of each case such financial assistance was being given only in cases involving the death of a Govt. employees while working in his office or on inspection, or while on tour or on his way to office or while returning from office to his residence.

2. Now in view of the increased cost of obsequies it was suggested that on exgratia payment of Rs. 300/- sanctioned at present may be enhanced to Rs. 500/- and the existing concession of giving advance of Rs. 1000/- or 3 months pay to the families of deceased Govt servants recoverable from DCRG or arrears of salary may be with drawn in view of the fact that the DCRG in majority or cases happens to be nearly encumbered with long term loans, like House building allowance additional advance for performing obsequies etc. may further encumber the DCRG.

3. The matter was considered at the A. P. Civil services joint staff council meeting held on 11-10-77 and it was recommended to enhance the ex-gratia amount

of Rs. 300/- to Rs. 500/- and the existing concession of giving advance of Rs.1000/- to the families of deceased to be recovered in accept the recommendation and the following amendments are issued:-

AMENDMENTS

In the annexure to G. o. Ms. No. 1669, General Administration (Services-F) Department, dt. 16 9.65, as subsequently amended in G.O.Ms.No. 1052, General Administration (services-F) Department dt. 5-8-66 and in G.O. Ms. No. 304, General Administration (Seivices-F) Department dt. 27-4-77.

a) The existing rule 3 under "sanction of expenditure" shall be substituted as under:-

3. The amount that may be sanctioned by the Head of office for the purpose shall not be more than rupees five hundred"

4. The orders with drawing the advance of Rs. 1000/- sanctioned in G.O Ms. No. 295, Finance and Planning (Accts. & loans) dated 31-10-75 towards relief to Govt. servants who die in harness will issue separately.
