ORDER:

Consequent on the occurrence of a chain of sudden deaths of Govt. employees while working in offices it was suggested to Govt to consider either to meet the expenses for cremation of the body, if there is no family, or kith and kin, or, in the alternative, transport the body to the native place of the deceased and hand it over to the nearest kith and kin. The Govt. have examined the above suggestion and have been considering for some time past the question of relief that may be offered to the Govt. employees dying in harness, while working in offices or on tour or on Inspection as one of the welfare measures. The scheme prepared for the purpose and approved by the Govt. is set forth in the annexure to this order.

2. The rules in the scheme will apply to every Govt. employees of the state of A.P. and an amount not less than rupees fifty and not more than rupees three hundred will be sanctioned having due regard to the circumstances of each case by the Head of the office who is the sanctioning authority. The expenditure in this regard will be met from the contingent provision of the Department or office concerned.

3. All the Departments of Secretariat and Heads of Departments are requested to make necessary provision in the budget of their Department for meeting the above expenditure.
