ABSTRACT**

Pay Fixation - Fixation of pay on promotion from a post which carries special pay to a post which does not carry special pay - Cancellation - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

A P U S

Orders were issued in the G.O. read above treating the special pay sanctioned to the Typists and Stenographers with reference to the qualifications in Type-writing and Stenography as basic pay for purpose of fixation of pay when promoted to a higher post which does not carry special pay with effect from 1-1-1974.

2. The matter was examined in detail keeping in view the facility available in the Government of India. In Government of India there is no practice of treating special pay as pay for purpose of fixation of pay on promotion to a higher post. There is also no practice of reckoning special pay as pay for calculation of D.A., H.R.A., C.C.A. and Pension. The orders issued in the G.O. read above are applicable only to the Typists and Stenographers when they are promoted to a post which does not carry special pay.

3. The special pays are sanctioned on acquiring Stenography or Typewriting while discharging their duties as Stenographer or Typist. The Special pays should, therefore, be admissible to them as long as they perform or discharge the above duties. The Government have been sanctioning certain special pays to other Government employees also for performing arduous nature of duties. Such special pay is admissible to them as long as they discharge those duties. When they are transferred to other places or promoted to other posts in their departments the special pays are not treated as pay for purpose of fixation of pay and also for pension. By treating the special pay drawn by the stenographers and Typists as pay for purposes of fixation of pay on promotion, the employees are getting un-intended benefit. The above benefits are not available to other employees of State Government.

4. Therefore, the Government, after careful examination of the matter have come to the conclusion that the facility of treating the special pay as pay for purpose of fixation of pay on promotion to a post which does not carry special pay to a particular category of employees is not justified.

5. Now therefore, the Government hereby direct that the orders issued in G.O. Ms. No. 27. Finance and Planning (Fin. Wing - FR-II) Department dated 17th January. 1978 be cancelled with immediate effect.
