Public Service – Education – Preponement of increment of senior on par with his junior in the regrouped scales – Orders-Issued.

ORDER :-

APUS

In the G.O. first read above, orders were issued allowing the teachers to get their increment on the date on which they would have drawn their increments, had they continued in the pre-regrouped scales of pay. It has been represented to the Government that the similar facility was not allowed to the seniors to draw their next increment on the same date as admissible to his junior, if the date of increment of his Junior is earlier in spite of the fact that the junior's pay was fixed at the same stage as that fixed for the teacher senior to him in the same cadre in the pre-regrouped scales of pay. To the increment given earlier to the juniors, seniors are drawing less pay than their juniors in the regrouped scales of pay. Government have examined the issue carefully and they have decided to rectify this situation.

2. Government accordingly direct that in the case of a teacher whose pay in the regrouped scales of 1982 is fixed on 1-12-1982 at the same stage as that fixed for another teacher junior to him in the same cadre and drawing pay at a lower stage than his junior in the existing scale of pay, prior to that date, the next increment shall be deemed to have accrued on the same date as admissible, to his junior, if the date of increment of the junior is earlier.
