ORDER :

APUS

According to Appendix -I of Revised Pension Rules 1980, every Head of the Department/Head of the Office shall have the list of all Government servants due to retire on attaining the age of superannuation during the next 18 months, prepared once in every 6 months i.e., on the 1st January and 1st July each year covering both Gazetted, Non-gazetted and Last Grade Government Servants and forward this, list to the Pension Verifying Authority concerned not later than the 31st January and the 31st July as the case may be, of that year. The Pension-Sanctioning Authority shall send pension papers to the A.G.(A&E)/L.F. Authority, six months before the known date of retirement and ensure that the retiring Government Servant shall get the payment of pension on the date on which he would have received his salary but for his retirement.

2. Government have taken various measures to expedite disposal of pension cases and to remove any bottleneck in the settlement of pension cases. Government have also been considering to remove any intermediary authority by which means the Pension Papers could be moved to AG(A&E)/LF Authority directly and to see that a retiring Government servant shall get his pension on the date on which he would have received his salary but for his retirement.

With a view to settle the pension cases expeditiously and to avoid the intermediary officers the Government have decided to delegate the powers to sanction pension to the authorities indicated below:

3.The above delegation of powers shall not be applicable to the employees working in the Aided Educational Institutions. Their cases shall continue to be processed under the existing instructions in force. The Head of the office who forwards the Pension Papers to AG(A&E)/LF Authority should inform the cadre controlling authority of the retiring employee for his information and record.

4. All the Heads of the Departments are requested to notify the Heads of Offices under their Administrative control immediately to the AG(A&E)/LF. Authority

5. Necessary amendments to the A.P.R.P.Rs. 1980 shall be issued separately
