ORDER:

In Go First read above, orders were issued implementation of the recommendations, of the pay revision commission, 1999 with certain modification in pursuance of the discussions with the joint action committee of employees, teachers and workers of Andhra Pradesh the telangana non – gazette officers union and the A.P. Secretaries Co-ordination committee with effect from 1st July 1998 with monetary benefit from 01-11-1999. Among other things it was agreed to constitute committee to look in to the anomalies that many arises as a result to implementation of the recommendation of the pay revision commission. In the reference second read above, orders have been issued consolidating pension in respect of pensioners who retired prior to 01-07-1998 duly allowing weight age of 6%, 3% and 2% in respect of pensioners who retired prior to 01-07-74, between 01-01- 78 and between 1-4-78 and 30-6-1986 respecting are recommended by the pay revision commission, 1999 government vide G.O. 3rd read above have appointed as anomalies committee under the a chairmanship of sri R. Ranachandra I.A.S.,(Rtd) the committee has since submitted its report to the government in the reference 4th read above.

2. The committee among other things, made the following recommendation on pensionary benefits.

- i). Inclusion of widowed/divorced daughter and parents who were totally dependent on Govt. Servant while he was alive and were the deceased employee left behind neither window nor a child in the definition of family for purpose of family pension.

Committee hereby order inclusion of windowed /divorced daughter and parents who were totally dependent on employee left behind neither window nor a child in the definition of family for purpose of family under sub – rule 12 of rule 50 of Andhra Pradesh revised pension rules, 1980.

i). The family pension in respect of sons/daughters (Including widowed/divorced daughter) will be admissible subject to the condition that the payment should be discontinued/not admissible when the eligible son / daughter starts earning a sum of Rs. 2440/- (Rupees Two Thousand Four Hundred Forty Only) per month from employment in the Government, Private, Self employment etc., It is further clarified that the family pension to the sons / daughters will be admissible till he /she attains 25 years of age or up to the date of his / her marriage / remarriage which ever is earlier.

4. Government have also decided not to entertain any grievances recommendations of the anomalies Committee in the wake of constitution of the 8th revision commission as ordered in G.O. 5th and 6th read above.

5. Necessary amendments to the Andhra Pradesh revised rules, 1980 where ever necessary will be Issued separately.

6. These order will come into force with immediate effect.

7. All pension disabusing officers are i.e. all treasury officers / pension / payment officers are Requested to implement these orders with authorization from the accountant general (A&E), A.P. Hyderabad.

8. The expenditure is alterable among the various states in accordance with the provisions of G.O. Ms.No. 198, finance Dt. 10-07-69.

9. The expenditure shall be debited to the pension funds of zilla parishads in co far as non –Government pensioners of panchayat Raj Institutions are concerned and pension fund of the Respective municipal councils in so for as the non – teaching and non – government pensioners of the municipalities are concerted and the relevant head of account of Government in so far as the teachers are concerned.
