Government have issued orders in the reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited that where an employee's date of increment falls due on the day following his retirement. He may be given the benefit of increment notionally purely for the par pose of pensioner benefits.

The Accountant general A.P. Hyderabad in his, letter 2<sup>nd</sup> cited has informed that in cases where annual increment falls due for sanction after the date submission of pension paper but before the date of retirements his office has been presuming sanction of increments and admitting pensionary benefits. The fulfillment of condition under note of rule 31 and note 1 under rule 32 of certificate indicating payment after sanction 1980 is ensure by watching receipt of last pay certificate Indicating payment after sanction of his increment presume by his office and an amount of Rs. 1000/- is withheld from gratuity for this purpose.

The has further stated that in cases received in advance to the date of retirement, it is proposed to leave the matter to the responsibility of the pension sanctioning authority and his office counts the notional increment it the department authority counts the same and request to issue necessary instruction to all pension sanctioning authorities to ensure correctness of sanction of national increment in respect of cases sent to his office in advance.

After careful examination of the matter an pension sanctioning authorizes are hereby instructed to ensure correctness of notional increment in respect of cases sent to accountant general's office in advance.
