Sub: Pension-Authorization of Pension payment Order in Respect of children of pensioners suffering from Disorder or disability of Mind or physically Crippled or Disabled-Instructions-Issued.

As per the orders issued in the reference 1st and 2nd cited, if the son or daughter of a Government servant is suffering from any disorder or disability of mind or is physically crippled or disabled, so as to render him or her unable to earn a living even after attaining the age of 25 years, the Family Pension is payable to such son or daughter for life time subject to conditions laid down.

2. In the reference 3rd cited certain representation have been received from Retd. Government servants requesting the Government to indicate on the Pension Payment Order of the Retired Government servant, the Family Pension admissible to their mentally retarded sons/daughters of physically crippled or disabled sons/daughters as their sons/daughters cannot pursue the matter with the offices to get their Family pension after the demise of the pensioner.

3. Government have examined the matter carefully and with a view to avoid hardship to such children, the Accountant General, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad and Director of Local Fund Audit, Hyderabad, are requested to indicate on the pension payment orders the name and eligibility of children suffering from any disorder or disability of mind or is physically crippled or disabled, if reported by Government servants while submitting the pension papers or later so as to enable such children to get family pension without any difficulty after the death of the pensioner and after exhausting all the eligible family members as per orders issued in the reference 1st cited. The pensioner has to appoint a Guardian to receive the Family pension by such children.
