The attention of the director of treasuries and accounts A.P Hyderabad is invited to the reference cited, and he is informed that in all those cases where an in service employee who was covered under the earlier pension rules joins another organization department where the same rules applicable, after submitting a technical resignation, such employees will be treated outside the purview of new contributory pension scheme. In other words they would continue to remain under the earlier pension rules in those cases, where past services are not counted for pensioner and other recruitment benefit, the concerned employees may be treated to be covered under the new pension scheme.
