**ORDER:**

Orders were issued in the Government order 1st read above to treat the last emoluments for fixation of Pension under rule 45(2)(b) of Andhra Pradesh Revised Pension rules, 1980, instead of average of last 10 months emoluments as per rule 32 of Andhra Pradesh Revised Pension Rules, 1980, provided officiation in a promoted post during the last 2 months preceding the Correct retirement, is in a regular Vacancy. Orders were issued in the G.O. Second read above revising the Pay Scales of the employees with effect from 01.07.1998 with monetary benefit from 01.04.1999.

2. Accountant General, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad in the reference 6th read above stated that in respect of cases where the provisions of the G.O.1st read above are not satisfied, the Pension has to be computed on the average of last 10 months and request the Government to issue necessary orders for reckoning the emoluments for the periods in the revised and pre-revised scales of Pay. He also requested to clarify about the payment of differential amounts on Gratuity and commutation of pension on the pay revised in the Revised Pay Scales, 1999.

3. After careful examination, Government issue the following Orders:-

1. In respect of Government Servants retiring on or after 01.07.1998 with the benefit of Revised Pay Scales of 1999 and whose cases are not satisfied the provisions of the G.O.1st read and their pensions have to be determined on the average of last 10 months emoluments as per rule 32 of Andhra Pradesh Revised Pension Rules, 1980 and if Pay

was drawn during the period of 10 months preceding the date of retirement partially in the pre-revised scales of pay and partially in the revised pay scales, 1999, in addition to pay drawn by the employees in the pre-revised scales of pay, dearness allowance drawn by the employee as on 01.07.1998 i.e. The D.A. Being counted for the propose of Pay fixation in the Revised Scales of pay in RP Scales, 1999 may also be counted for working out average emoluments fir computing Pension. The pensioners retired on or after 01.07.1998with the benefit of Revised Pay Scales 1999 would 01.07.1998 with the benefit of Revised Pay Scales 1999 would be eligible for relief on pension sanctioned in the G.O.3rd read above and not eligible for earlier relief's.

2. Orders were issued in the G.O.4th and 5th read above to pay arrears on gratuity and commutation of pension in three installments. The date of first installment paid for communication of pension shall be taken into the account for the purpose of date of communication under ANDHRA PRADESH Commutation Rules of all purpose i.e., Restoration of Commuted value of Pension etc.

4. Accountant General, Andhra Pradesh, is requested to take necessary action accordingly.
