ORDER:

APUS ****

Orders were issued in the G.Os 1st to 3rd read above for restoration of commuted portion of pension. Subsequently, Government of India have issued orders for restoration of commuted portion of pension vide their Lr. 4th read above. According to these orders commuted portion of pension is to be restored on the expiry of 15 years from the date of retirement if the commutation was simultaneous with retirement. In other cases where the date of commutation is subsequent to the date of retirement thereby causing & time gap between retirement and commutation, the restoration would take place only on the expiry of 15 years from the date of commutation. The Accountant General, A.P. Hyderabad in his letter & 5th read above had also requested the Government to issue orders as to the date of restoration as a number of pensioners are approaching Accountant General's Office for restoration at the age of 70 years as per the Judgment of the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh vide W.P.No.12148/88.

2. Government have examined the matter carefully and it decided to adopt the orders of Govt. of India for restoration of commuted portion of pension with effect from 1-4-1990. Accordingly the orders issued vide G.Os. 1st to 3rd read above are hereby cancelled with effect from 1-4-1990 and the commuted portion of pension shall be restored to pensioners on completion of 15 years from their date of retirement, if the commutation was simultaneous with retirement. If there is any time gap between the date of retirement and date of commutation, the commuted portion of pension shall be restored after expiry of 15 years from the date of commutation, i.e. from the date on which reduction in pension on account of commutation became/ becomes effective.
3. No pensioner shall be entitled to commute his/her pension again on the ground that the commuted portion has been restored to him/her.
4. These orders shall take effect from 1-4-1990.
