ORDER: -

In the G.O.3rd read above orders were issued laying down the terms of reference of the pay revision commission which include matters relating to pension in the G.O. 4th read above orders were issued appointing Sri. R.K.R. Gonela . LAS., (Retd.) as pay revision commissioner the pay revision commission submitted his report on 21-7-1997 the commission recommended inter – allow that commutation of pension up to 40% may be permitted.

According to A.P. Civil pension (Commutation) Rules, 1944, A Government servant to whom these rules will apply shall subject to the conditions there in specified be allowed to commute for a lump payment any portion not exceeding one third of the pension granted to him by the state Government.

After careful consideration of the report, Government decided to implement the recommendations of the pay revision commissioner and hereby order that the limit for commutation of pension under A.P civil pension (commutation) rules, 1944 shall be enhanced to 40% of the pension sanctioned to the pensioner. All other provisions for this purpose shall remain unchanged.

These orders will come into force from 01-04-1999 and shall apply to all Government servants retire or chose death taken place on or after that date. The arrears due to issue of these order to the employees retired after 01-04-1999 shall be paid as per Para 4.4 of the Government order fifth read above. The pensioners who have already commuted their claims shall be settled as per the orders issued in the reference first and second read above.

Necessary amendments to the relevant rules shall be issued separately.
