ORDER:



As per G.O. Ms. No. 201, General Administration Department, dt. 1-2-62 Govt. servants promoted from a lower cadre or transferred from another service should be placed on probation of satisfactory service of one year within a continuous period of 2 years.

- 2. As per rule 3 of the rules relating to establishments under P.Samithis and ZPs. issued in G-O. Ms. No. 36, P & L.A, dt. 17-7-62 teachers under Z.Ps. and P Samithis are placed on probation of satisfactory service of two years within a continuous period of 3 years on every appointment to a post in superior service.
- 3- The Director of Public instruction in his letter read above has requested that the orders mentioned in Para 1 above may be made applicable to the teachers working in Z.Ps. and P.Samithis to maintain uniformity.
- 4. The D.P.I, has also separately submitted drafts rules of A.P.P. Raj Subordinate Service rules exclusively for teaching staff working in P.Samithis and Z.Ps. and it may take time for this finalization. Govt. therefore consider that in the meantime the teachers working under P.Samithis and Z.Ps. should not be put to disadvantage.
- 5, They, therefore direct that the orders referred to in a Para I above be 'extended to the teachers working in Z-Ps. and P.Samithis for the present till the finalization of draft rules referred to above.
