**ORDER:**

On the request of the teachers representatives, the Commissioner and Director of School Education has sent proposal vide reference cited for considering regularization of the services of temporary teachers working in Panchayat Raj Institutions, who were appointed after 31-12-1980 on the basis of the regularization orders issued in respect of teachers who were appointed prior to 31-12-1980 in G.O.Ms.No.228, Education dt. 20-5-1986.

2. The Cabinet Sub-committee, after careful consideration, has also agreed to the request made by the teachers representatives.

3. Government accordingly direct that the service of Temporary Panchayat Raj teachers who were appointed after 31-12-1980 and before selections were made by District Selection Committee in 1983 and are continuing in service shall be regularized subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions.

- i) The selection should have been made to sanctioned posts carrying a time scale and by having followed the selection procedure as prescribed then,
- ii) The regularization shall be made through Special District Selection Committee constituted for this purpose even if they are over aged but otherwise eligible.
- iii) Wherever relaxation of age rule is involved all such cases of overaged persons as on date of appointment shall be referred to Government, after they are selected by Special District Selection Committee for orders.

4. Government further direct that the Chief Executive officers. District Educational Officers shall verify the above said aspects in each individual case and take further action to regularize only the eligible cases. Any improper regularization shall be viewed seriously and the financial implications/losses sustained by the Government on account of such irregular action is liable to be recovered from the staff concerned apart from taking other action as per rules.

5. All District Collectors are requested to take necessary immediate action in matter.
