ORDER:

As per G.O. Ms. No. 201, General Administration Department, dated 1-2-1962, Government servants promoted from a Lower cadre or transferred from another service should be placed on probation of satisfactory service of one year within a continuous period of 2 Years

2. As per Rule 3 of the rules relating to establishments under Panchayat Samithis and Zilla Parishads issued in G.O. Ms. No. 936,P & L.A. , dated. 17-7-62, teachers under Zilla Parishads and Panchayat Samithis are placed on probation of satisfactory service of two years within a continuous period of 3 years on ever appointment to a post in a superior service.

3. The Director of Public Instruction in his letter read above has requested that the orders mentioned in para 1 above may be made applicable to the teachers working in Zilla Parishads and Panchayat Samithis to maintain uniformity.

4. The Director of Public Instruction has also separately submitted draft rules of Andhra Pradesh Panchayat Raj Subordinate Service Rules exclusively for teaching staff working in Panchayat Samithis and Zilla Parishads and it may take time for its finalisation. Government therefore consider that in the meantime the teachers working under Panchayat Samithis and Zilla Parishads should not be put to disadvantage.

5. They, therefore direct that the orders referred to in Para 1 above extended to the teachers working in Zilla Parishads and Panchayat Samithis for the present till the implication of draft rules referred to above.
