PUBLIC SERVICES- Representation of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Class in Public Service - Certain concessions - Orders - Issued

ORDER:

A P U S

Under rule 22 of General Rules for the Andhra Pradesh State and Subordinate Services, where the Special Rules of a service lay down that the principle of reservation of appointments shall apply to any service, Class or Category the percentage of reservation prescribed therein for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes and for Open competition shall apply for recruitment to such Service, Class or Category . Under the above rule, if a qualified and suitable candidate belonging to any of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes or the Backward Classes is not available for appointment in the turn allotted for them in the cycle, then turn will lapse and the vacancy shall be filled by the next turn in the order of rotation specified therein. The government direct that the principle of reservation of appointments should be extended to all cadres including the Departments of Secretariat, to which it does not at present apply. If for any reason the rule of reservation cannot be made applicable to any post filled by promotion, a certain number of such posts in all cadres and in all departments may be reserved for direct recruitments, wherever possible. The rule of reservation should be applied to the posts so reserved for direct recruitment by amending the Special Rules suitably for the purpose. They also direct that, if the vacancies reserved for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes or the Backward Classes are not filled for want of qualified and suitable candidates, such vacancies should be carried forward and added as additional number of reserved vacancies for subsequent year for a period of two calendar years excluding the year of selection. If even after so carrying forward the number of vacancies a suitable number of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes candidates is not available for the vacancies reserved for them, such vacancies should be thrown open to the Backward Classes candidates and if the Backward Class candidates also are not available for appointment to the vacancies meant for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes they should be thrown open for Open competition. This principle should be followed commencing from the year 1961 i.e. 1-1-1961 pending amending of the relevant Service Rules for the purpose.

2. The Department of the Secretariat are requested to take necessary action to implement the above orders and to suitably amend the service rules with which they are concerned. Necessary amendments to general rules will be issued by this department.
