Sub: - P.R.C. Revised Pay Scales, 1986- Fixation of Pay in the Revised Pay Scales, 1986 – Particulars called for Instructions- Issued.

APUS

In the reference 1st cited instructions have been issued that all the pay fixations in the Revised Pay scales, 1986 shall be compiled by 31.3.1991. However, in the reference 2nd cited it has been stated that the fixation claims in the Revised Pay Scales, 1986 are pending.

2. Government have examined the matter and felt that the pay and allowances of the employees should be paid in the Revised Pay Scales 1986 only except in cases where the employees have opted to remain in the 1978 pay scales. Accordingly, Government hereby order that in cases where the pay fixation claims in the Revised Pay Scales 1986 have not been settled, the employees shall be allowed the minimum of the pay scale allowed to that category, in the Revised Pay Scales, 1986 pending feminization of the fixation in the Revised Pay Scales, 1986.

3. All the Audit Officers are requested to ensure before admitting any pay bills henceforth, that the pay fixations in the Revised Pay Scales, 1986 of that particular office have been completed. The Audit Officer shall not admit such part of any salary bill which is in the pre-revised scale.

4. Cases of pay fixation at-the minimum of the pay scales as indicated in Para 2 above would be done by issue of necessary proceedings by the competent authority.

5. Subsequently, when the fixation in the Revised Pay Scales, 1986 is proposed to be finalized by undertaking re-fixation on the basis of records which may since become available or for any other reason, such refutation shall be done with the prior concurrence of Government.

6. All the Heads of Departments and Departments of Secretariat are requested to communicate these orders to their Subordinate Officers and issue suitable instructions so that these instructions are implemented in letter and spirit.
