ORDER :

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued implementing the recommendations of the Pay Revision Commission, 1999 on the rates of recovery of rent for the Government Quarters allotted to Government employees.

2. In the reference second read above, the Director General and Inspector General of Police, A.P. Hyderabad felt that there is a contradiction between the orders issued in the reference first read above and the earlier orders in this regard. He requested to clarify whether the rate of recovery shall be 15% of emoluments of house rent.

3. The Government have examined the matter carefully. The intention of the Government is to continue the recovery of rent at the rates as were prevailing in the pre revised scales even in the Revised Pay Scales, 1999. Thus, there is no contradiction in the orders issued in this regard. However, to make the stand of the Government clear the following amendment is issued to the orders issued in the reference first read above.

AMENDMENT

For the second sentence in Para 3 of the G.O. First read above the following shall be substituted:

" In respect of employees who have taken House Building Advance and constructed houses or purchased ready built houses within or outside Twin Cities and are in occupation of Government Quarters, the rate of recovery shall be 15% of emoluments as house rent from the date from which House Building Advance Recovery commences and in respect of employees who have taken House Building Advance and who are occupying earmarked Government Quarters in Districts, the rate of recovery of rent shall be at 10% of emoluments".

4. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 1st July, 1998.
