ORDER :

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued revising the rates of City Compensatory Allowance as recommended by the Pay Revision Commission, 1993. In the order second read above, orders were issued sanctioning City Compensatory Allowance to the employees working at Guntur, Rajahmundry and Warangal based on the recommendations of the High Power Committee.

2. In the Government Order third read above, orders were issued constituting Pay Revision Commissioner. In the Government Order fourth read above, orders were issued appointing Sr. R.K.R.Gonela, IAS, (Retd) as Pay Revision Commissioner. In the Government order fifth read above, orders were issued revising the pay scales of the State Government employees as recommended by the Pay Revision Commission, 1999 with effect from 01.07.1998 with monetary benefit from 01.04.1999.

3. Among others, the Pay Revision Commission, 1999 recommended the following on the City Compensatory Allowance:

i) The existing scheme under which the rates of City Compensatory Allowance are linked to the twin cities of pay scales and classification of cities, is a satisfactory arrangement and it is neither desirable nor practicable to award this allowance as a percentage of basic pay.

ii) The classification of Cities made by Government of India and the rates enforced by that Government in respect of its employees may be adopted by the State Government in mutatis mutandis.

4. Government held discussions with the Office Bearers of the Joint Action Committee of Employees, Teachers and Workers, the Telangana Non-gazetted Officers Union and the Andhra Pradesh Secretariat Coordination Committee. It was decided to implement the recommendations of the Pay Revision Commission, 1999 from 01.04.1999 to 30.06.1999 shall be credited to the General Provident Fund Account of the Employees.

5. The Government have accepted the recommendations of the Pay Revision Commission and hereby sanction the revised rates of City Compensatory Allowance to the employees in different pay ranges in the Revised Pay Scales of 1999 as indicated below:

6. The pay for the purpose of calculation of City Compensatory Allowance Shall be the pay as defined as in FR 9(21) (a) (i)

7.1 The revised percentage rates of City Compensatory Allowance specified in Para fifth above shall not be applicable to the following categories of employees:

- (a) Those employees who opt to remain in the Andhra Pradesh Revised Pay Scales 1993.
- (b) Teachers working in the Universities, affiliated degree colleges both under Government and aided managements who are drawing pay in the Andhra Pradesh Revised UGC/ICAR/AICTE Pay Scales 1986/1996.
- (c) Officers belonging to All India Services.
- (d) Andhra Pradesh Higher Judicial Service and Andhra Pradesh State Judicial Service who are governed by the first National Judicial Pay Commission.

7.2 The categories of employees specified in 7.1 (a) above shall draw the allowances at the existing rates prescribed in the G.O.s first and second read above.

8. The City Compensatory Allowance at the above rates shall be admissible to:

- (a) all employees of the State Government;
- (b) the employees of the State Government;
- (c) the Work-charged establishment in receipt of pay in regular pay scale in the Revised Pay Scales of 1999.

9. These orders shall come into force with effect from 1st July, 1998 with monetary benefit from 01.04.1999. Revised rates of City Compensatory Allowance alongwith the Revised Pay Scales, 1999 from 01.04.1999 to 30.06.1999 shall be credited to the General Provident Fund Accounts. The revised rates of City Compensatory Allowance shall be paid in cash along with the salary in Revised Pay Scales, 1999 from 1st July, 1999.
