ORDER :

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued revising the pay scales of the State Government employees from 1.7.1998 with monetary benefit from 1.4.1999. While doing so, it was ordered that the persons who retired between 1.7.1998 and 31.3.1999 shall also be eligible for the Revised Pay Scales, 1999. The notional pay fixed in the Revised Pay Scales, 1999 in such cases count towards pensionary benefits. In the Government Orders second to fourth read above orders were towards pensionary benefits. In the Government Orders second to fourth read above, orders were issued revising Pensionary benefits as recommended by the Pay Revision Commission, 1999 and it was ordered that the employees who retired between 1.7.1998 and 1.4.1999 be eligible for fixation of pay in the Revised Pay Scales notionally and the pension be revised based on the notional pay so fixed. The monetary benefit however be allowed from 1.4.1999. No difference of Retirement Gratuity and Communication shall be allowed in the pension notionally fixed so. Thus, the orders revising the pay scales and pensionary benefits do not go hand in hand as far as allowing revised pay notionally fixed for purpose of pensionary benefits in respect of those who retired between 1.7.1998 and 1.4.1999. In the reference fifth read above, it has been requested to amend the orders issued in the G.O. first read above, to the effect of restricting the benefit of reckoning notional pay in respect of the employees retired between 1.7.1998 and 1.4.1999 to pension only with monetary benefit from 1.4.1999 to bring out the intention of the Government clearly.

2. Accordingly, the following amendment is issued to the orders issued in the Government Order first read above.

AMENDMENT

The following shall substitute Para 9 of the orders issued in the G.O. first read above.

"Persons who retired between 1.7.1999 shall also be eligible for the Revised Pay Scales, 1999. The notional pay fixed in the Revised Pay Scales, 1999 in accordance

with these orders, shall, in such cases count towards pension notionally and monetary benefit of the revised pension shall be allowed with effect from 1.4.1999."
