ORDER:

In the Government Orders first read above, orders were issued for payment of Special Compensatory Allowance, on the slabs based on the pay in the Revised Pay Scales, 1986 in the areas specified in the Annexure to G.O.Ms.No.297, Finance and Planning (FW.TA) Department, Dt.28-12-1991. The facility of Rent Free Quarters or Additional House Rent Allowance in lieu thereof was also sanctioned in the areas specified.

2.In the Government Order second read above, Government have issued orders for payment of Special Compensatory Allowance in Revised Pay Scales, 1993.

3.In the Government Order third read above, Government have issued orders introducing Revised Pay Scales, 1999. Consequently it has become necessary to redesign ate the slab ranges indicated in the Government Order second read above, in the Revised Pay Scales, 1999.

4.Accordingly, Government hereby order that the Special Compensatory Allowance shall be payable in a slab system on the basic pay drawn in Revised Pay Scales, 1999 at the following rates.

i)Special Compensatory Allowance (admissible at ordinary rates)

ii) Special Compensatory Allowance admissible at higher rates for the Scheduled Areas specified in G.O.Ms.No.9,Fin.. & Plg.. (FW.TA) Dept.,Dt.17-1-1992

The above rates shall be applicable only in respect of the employees drawing pay in Revised Pay Scales, 1999 but not in any other Pay Scales.

5.Additional House Rent Allowance in lieu of Rent Free Quarters thereof where payable shall be 8% of the basic pay of the employee under the Revised Pay Scales, 1999subject to a maximum of Rs.250/- per month .

6.Those eligible employees who continue to draw pay in the Revised Pay Scales,1993 or Revised UGC pay Scales, 1986 shall continue to draw these allowances as per the slab rates stipulated in the Government order second read above. Further, additional House Rent Allowance shall be payable to the eligible employees at 8% of the basic pay of the employee under the Revised Pay Scales,1993 or Revised U.G.C. Pay Scales, 1986, subject to a maximum of Rs.150/- per month.

7. These Orders shall come into force with effect from 1-4-1999, and the arrears from 1-4-1999 to 30-6-1999 shall be paid in cash with effect from 1-7-1999.

8. Necessary Amendments to the Andhra Pradesh Manual of Special Pays and Allowances will be issued in due course.
